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If you’re aware of GoFundMe donations being made in the name of your station, you can add them to your Pledge Sheet as such (on an honor basis) in order to accumulate greater totals for the Most Money Raised trophy.

Pull distance will be approx. 100 feet using SFD’s Rescue Truck.

Radio and/or PR interviews will be done prior and after pulls... if you’ve got a chatty Puller that you can designate for this job it will help the announcer keep things rolling.

Depending on the number of competing teams, we will have an elimination round or two to determine winners.

- Fastest time
- Most pledges/money raised
